The rollback rate for the Amarillo Junior College District for 2019 published in the legal notice is \$ 0.24919 per \$100 of assessed value.

Section 26.05 of the Property Tax Code requires a taxing unit to hold two public hearings on a tax rate if the recommended tax rate for the year exceeds the lower of the rollback tax rate or the effective tax rate. The recommended tax rate is \$ 0.22790.

7. REQUEST APPROVAL OF A CONSULTING SERVICES CONTRACT WITH CORWIN PRESS, INC. FOR DR. PAUL HERNANDEZ
