Previous Degree, Healthcare Certificate, or Healthcare work experience:

Applicants may earn two additional admission points for previous direct patient care experience. Qualifying experience must involve providing hands-on patient care as part of employment or military service. Examples include, but are not limited to, Medical Assistant, EMT, Paramedic, military medical personnel, and other positions involving direct patient care. Must provide documentation via verification of employment, certificates, and degrees submitted to the AC registrar's office.

CNA and LVN certificates are not accepted, due to these being set requirements.
