Program applicants complete the ATI TEAS Version 7 Admission Assessment Exam. Exam results are valid for one year prior to the application period. Please note: - There will be no rounding of the TEAS Exam content scores. - Applications with a composite TEAS score below 58.7% (Proficient) will not be considered for admission.
