Thank you for your letter of April 14, 2009, conveying the prospectus for two new off-campus instructional sites at which 50% or more of a program's credits are available. Courses have been offered at these sites since 1996:

Amarillo High School
4225 Danbury
Amarillo, TX 79109

Randall High School
5088 Attebury
Amarillo, TX 79118

As of what date did 50% or more of a program's credits become available at each site?

Programs available at these sites: Biotechnology, Forensic Science, Modern Languages, Pre-Physician Assistant, Pre-Physical Therapy. In addition, the Amarillo High School site also offers Biology. Classes are delivered face-to-face on the high school campus or remotely via interactive television or the World Wide Web using the WebCT platform. Physical facilities appear adequate.

Please provide the following information:

- Resubmit the faculty roster **using the form published on our website:** www.sacscoc.org under "Substantive Changes."
- Description of the **discipline-specific** library and learning resources available to the students enrolled at these sites.
- **Site-specific budgets** showing sources of funding for the programs and how it is allocated to support them. Where does the money come from? Where does it go?

Action on the proposal will be deferred pending review of the requested information.
