College Ready (of those for which we have data)

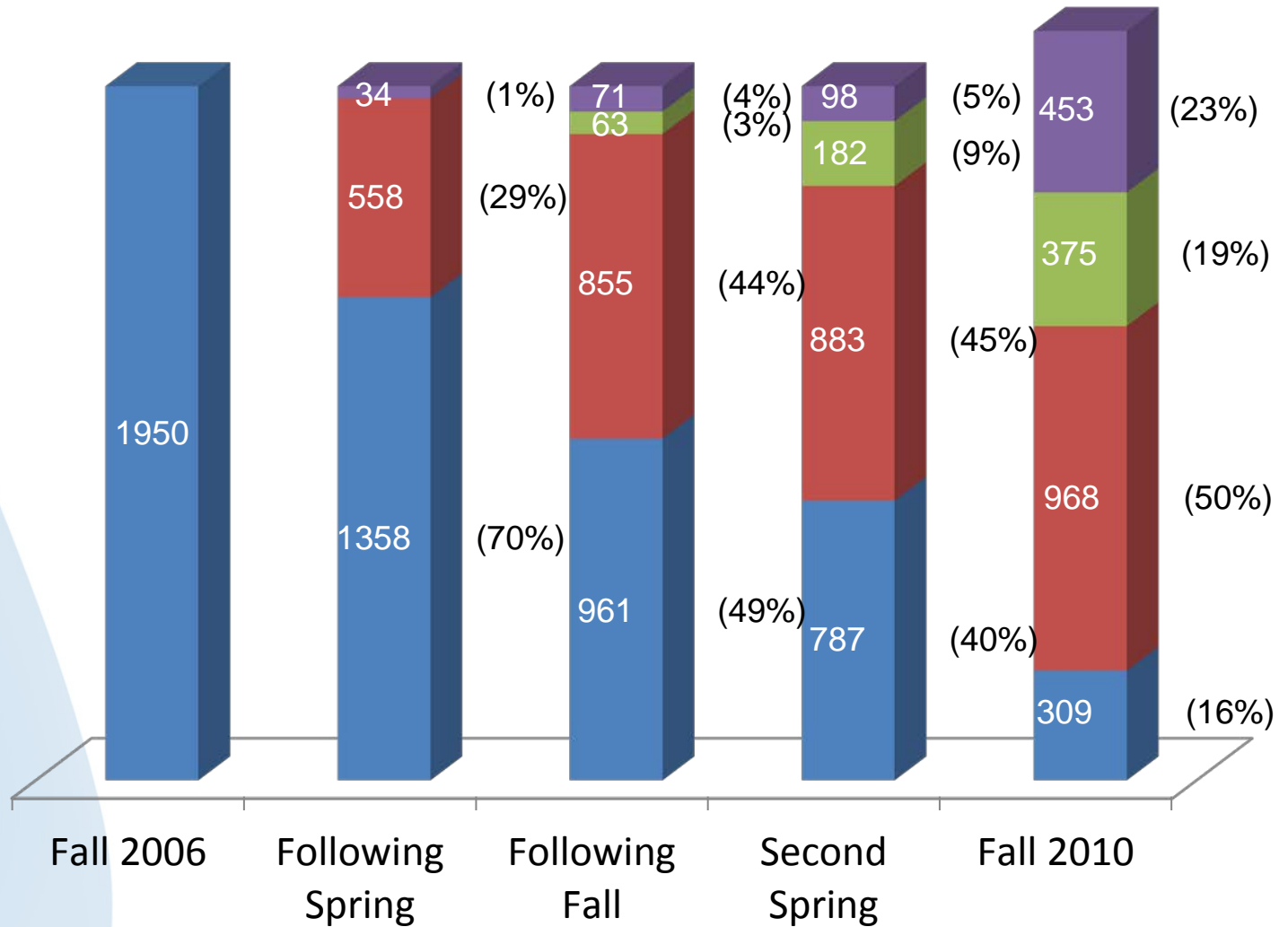

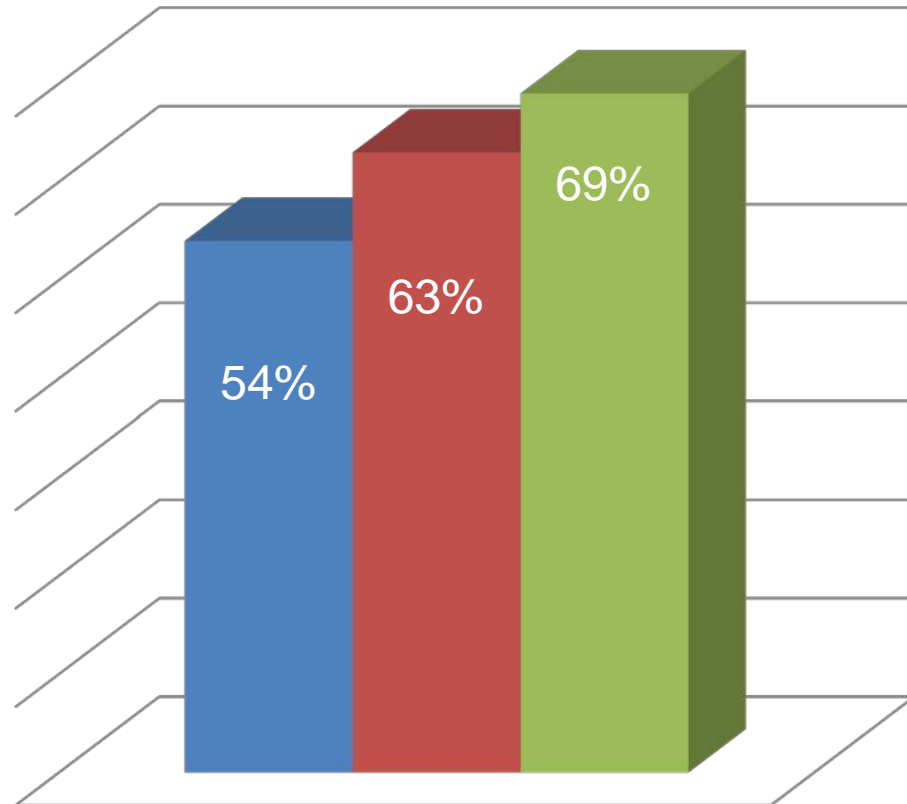

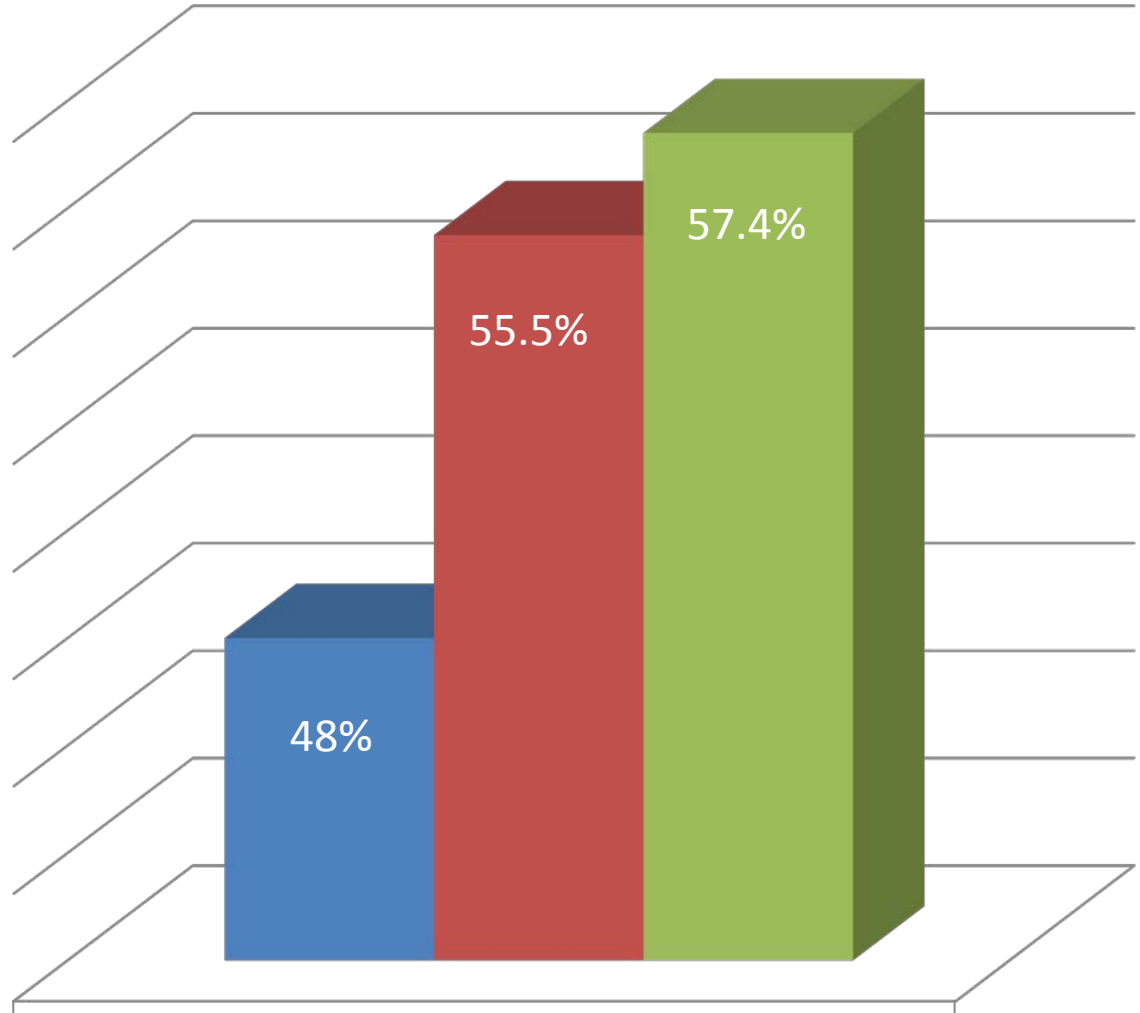

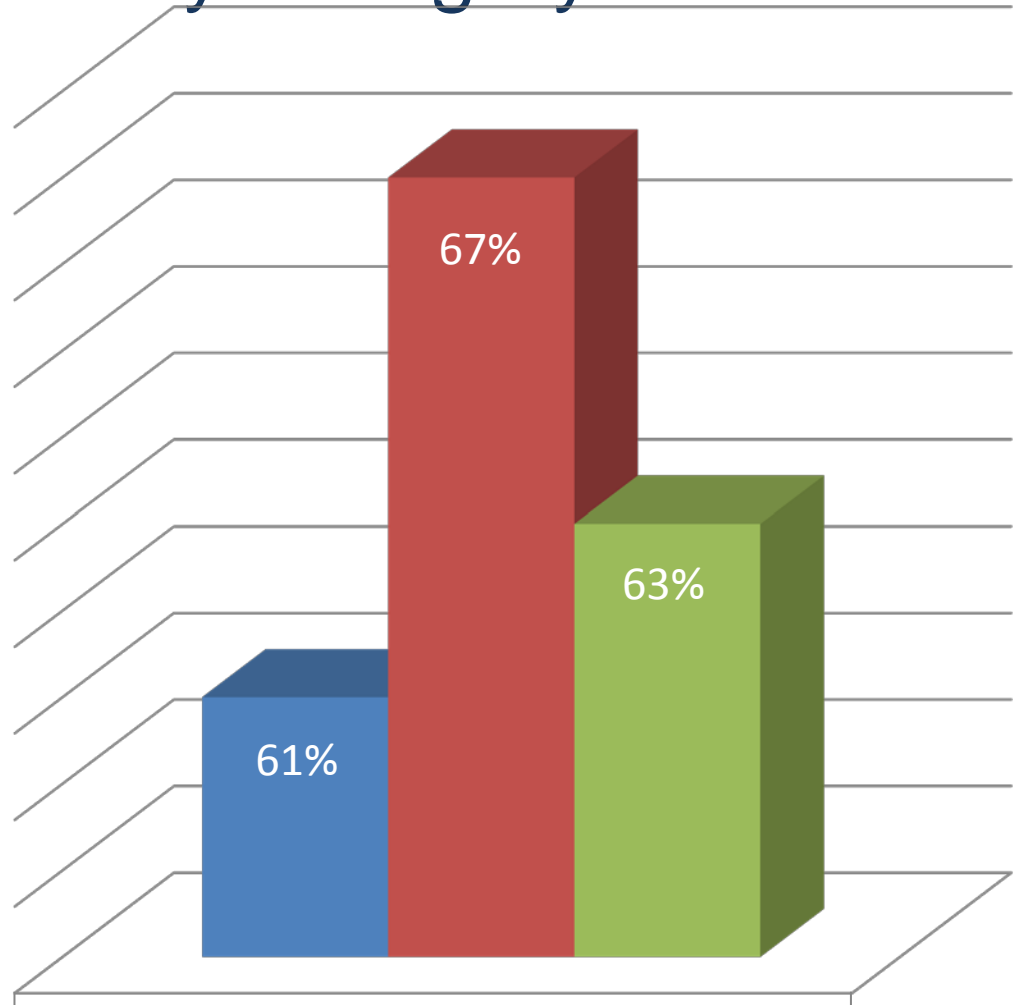
