Dear Dr. Matney:

Thank you for your letter of March 9, 2012, and prospectus for the institution's dual credit off-campus instructional sites. The unreported substantive change, 12 high school locations where the institution offered 50% or more of degree or certificate program, was addressed in our letter, dated October 11, 2012. The College's revised policy and procedure for reporting substantive changes was reviewed and accepted by the SACSCOC Board of Trustees at its December 2012 meeting.

High schools where dual credit classes are offered provide rooms, furniture, computers, and lab equipment and supplies for enrolled students. Faculty members appear to have appropriate credentials. Library and learning resources are provided in two physical locations: the Washington Street campus and West campus, as well as online. Online tutorials provide library instruction. The institution's students may access the Harrington Library Consortium catalog.

While the submitted prospectus contained limited faculty information, and additional faculty information was sent via email, we still do not have a completed Faculty Roster form to review. Please send a completed Faculty Roster form. This requested information should arrive in my office by April 25, 2013. We accept notification of these 12 sites where the institution offers 50% or more of a program and defer further action pending review of requested information.
