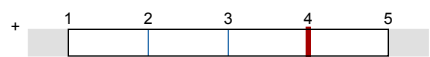

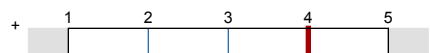

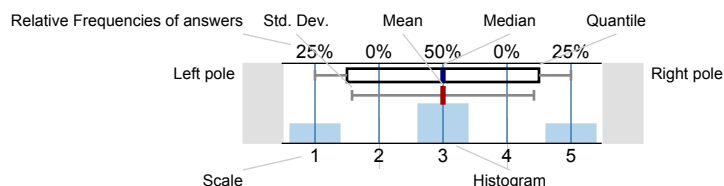

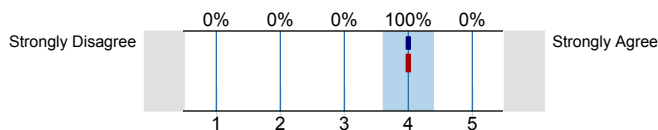

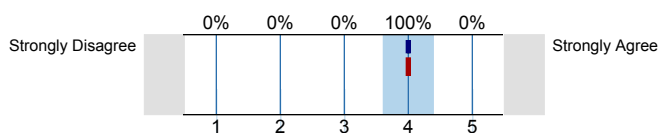

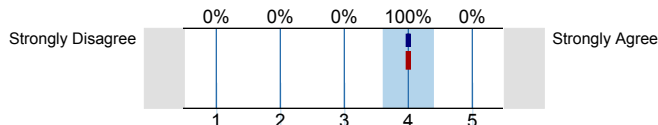

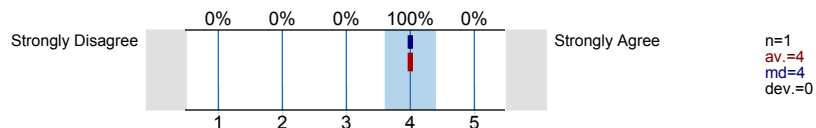

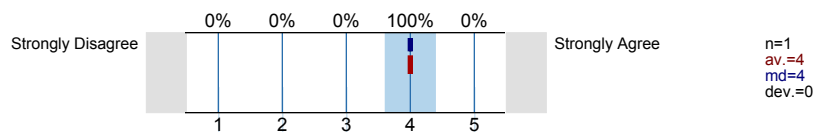

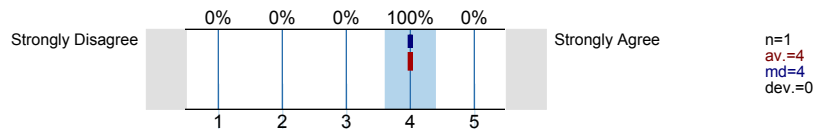

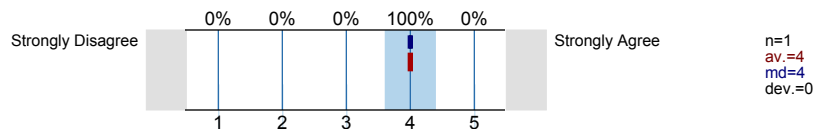

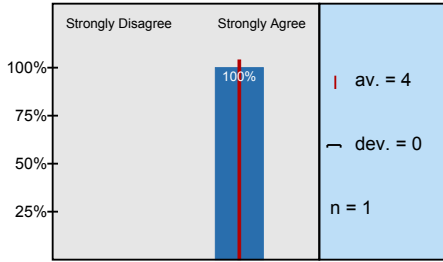

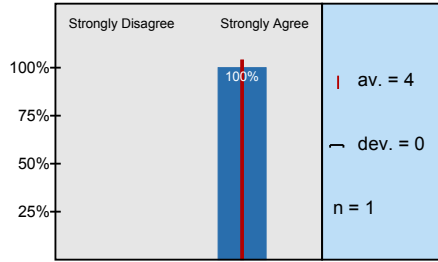


Histogram for scaled questions

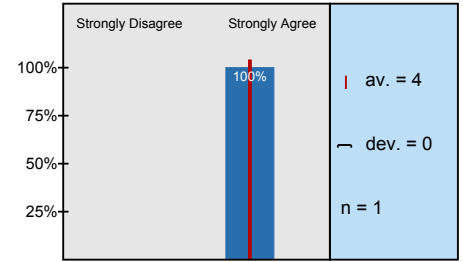

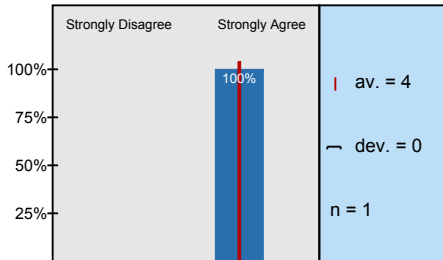

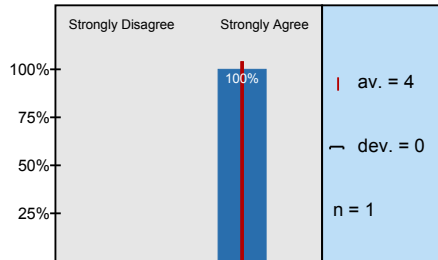

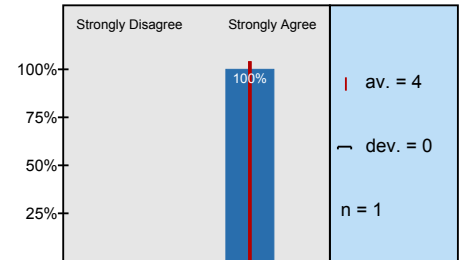

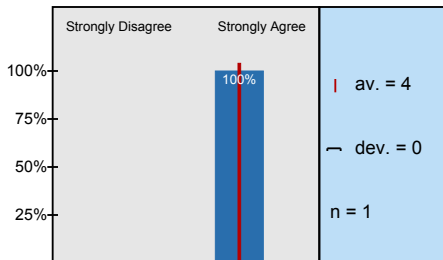
