## Introduction for the ideal Blackboard Assessment Setup- Assignment Drop Box in Blackboard Learning Management System

1. The student work is submitted through a drop box assignment (**it must be the student, not faculty!**) in the Blackboard system. The work can be submitted as a written text or a link in the assignment's text box area as an uploaded document in the assignment drop box.
2. Create the drop box assignment in the **Common Assessment** folder located in the Blackboard Course Menu.
3. Set the assignment drop box to accept only one attempt (See option assignment area).
4. If possible, request students submit an assignment that does not contain his/her name.
