I. Review/Approval of Minutes from November 9, 2010

II. Discussions/Information

- **Lee M. Colaw - Angel Transition**
 - Lee M. Colaw distributed a memo to the Academic Technology Committee and provided detailed information about the status of Angel version 7.4 and the timeline for transition to BlackBoard NG or another viable alternative called Moodlerooms
 - Amarillo College will continue in its planning for a migration to Blackboard NG, however, faculty are encouraged to look at a viable alternative named Moodlerooms which is closely integrated with the College's existing Datatel system. If there are any faculty concerns about the transition to Blackboard NG then all faculty are encouraged to talk to their colleagues, ATC, and the Center for Teaching and Learning about the Moodlerooms alternative. A decision as to whether the faculty want to transition to BlackBoard NG or Moodlerooms is required by December 2011.
- **iOS Think Tank - Scott Beckett, Instructor, Music**
 - Scott Beckett spoke to the committee about starting an iOS Think Tank to explore new technology. Mindy Graham made a motion to support the iOS Think Tank. The motion was seconded by Bob Johnson and passed. Scott can be contacted for more information.
- **Review ATC Charter – Recommendation – Daniel Ferguson, Victoria Taylor-Gore, Mindy Graham**
 - The handout of the ATC Charter recommendations from Dan Ferguson, Victoria Taylor-Gore and Mindy Graham were reviewed by the committee. It was determined that each ATC member would give their area a chance to review and make changes before the next meeting. Forward Dan any changes or updates before the next meeting. A finalized document will be voted on at the next meeting.
- **AC Online/Internet Explorer - Patsy Lemaster & Daniel Ferguson – (Firefox preferred Browser)**
 - There has been an issue with assessing links in Angel when using Internet Explorer. As a result, CTL has designated Firefox as the preferred browser for AC Online. CTL has reported the problem to Blackboard but no solutions have been found. If additional problems arise using Firefox, alternative directions will be provided as available and possible.
