*Symantec Anti-Virus is a program that works to keep your computer free of malicious software such as viruses, Trojan horses, and spyware.*

8. Click the tab "Scan for Threats".

You have two options at this point:

1. Log in and run a manual scan weekly. (Follow step 9.)

2. Set a scan to run automatically, and just leave your computer on at this scheduled time. (Follow steps 10 through 16.)
