



How to Download a Mozilla CCleaner

(These instructions apply to all PC users)

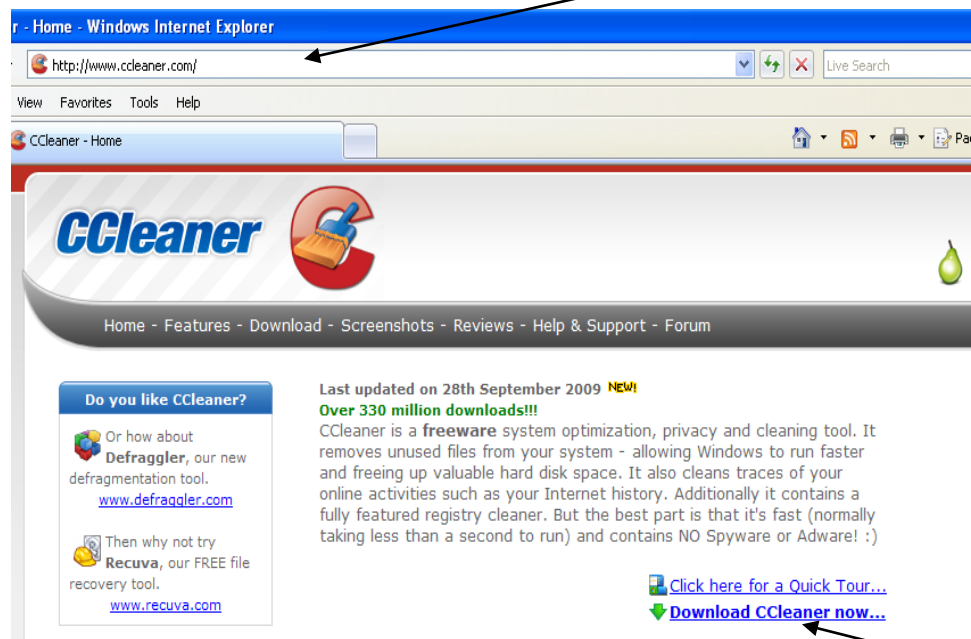
What is CCleaner?

CCleaner (formerly Crap Cleaner) is a freeware utility program used to optimize a user's computer performance and clean its registry. It removes unused files from your system - allowing Windows to run faster and freeing up valuable hard disk space. It also cleans traces of your online activities such as your Internet history. Additionally it contains a fully featured registry cleaner. But the best part is that it's fast.

How to Download CCleaner

Open a browser window (this example uses Internet Explorer) and type in www.ccleaner.com in the address bar; press Enter on the keyboard:

Type www.ccleaner.com in address bar and press Enter



Click here

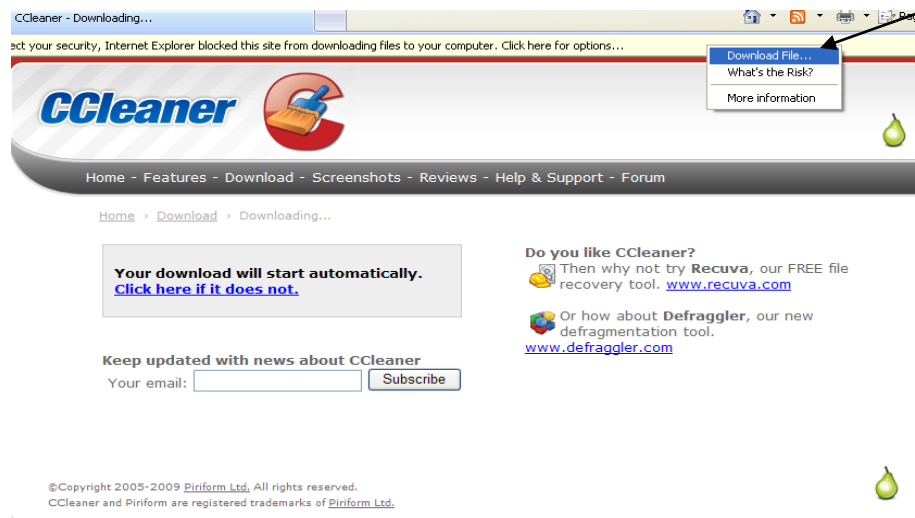
Click on the 'Download CCleaner now' in the window that opens to start the download process.

As CCleaner is a 'freeware' product, it is a free download. However, as with most 'freeware' products, donations are accepted to keep the product up-to-date. On the window that opens to begin the download process, you will see links where donations are accepted. You will also see options that will explain the version of CCleaner, other suggested downloads, etc. Click the link 'Alternative Download'.

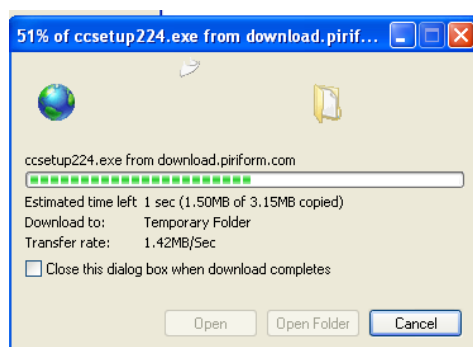
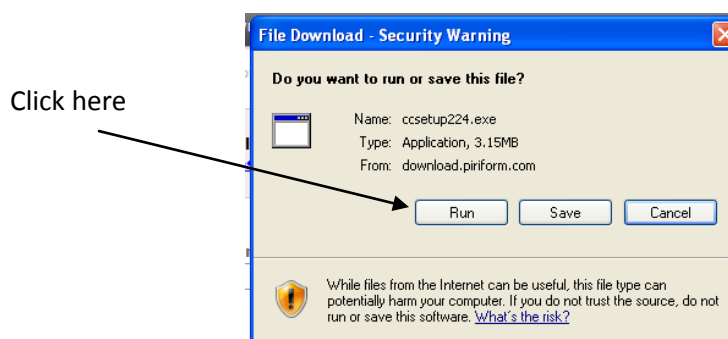


The CCleaner Download window will open (if you have your pop-up windows disabled, a yellow bar will show at the top of this window which will prevent the download window from opening. Right click in the yellow bar and click on 'Download File')

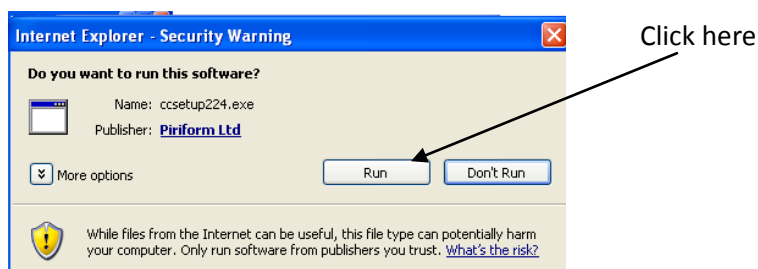
Right click in the yellow bar and click 'Download File'



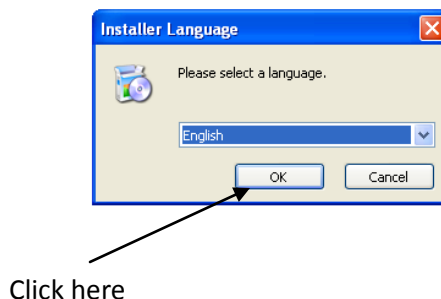
You will get a 'File Download – Security Warning' window. Click Run; a status window will follow.



Once downloaded, another security alert will appear because the file did not come from Internet Explorer; click Run.



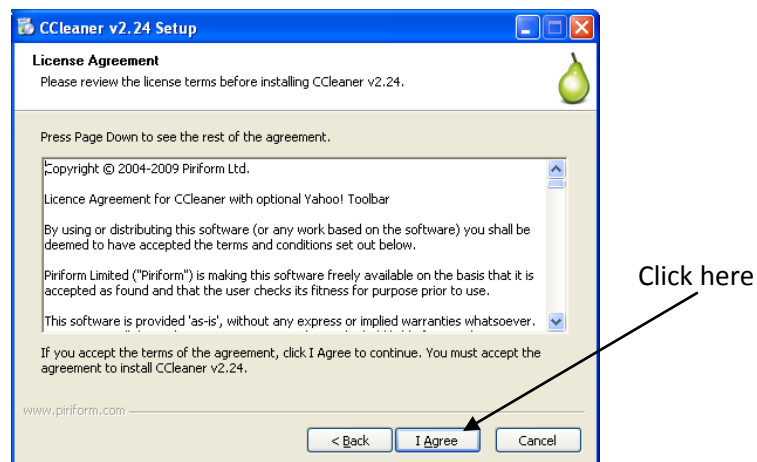
Select English for the installer language and click OK.



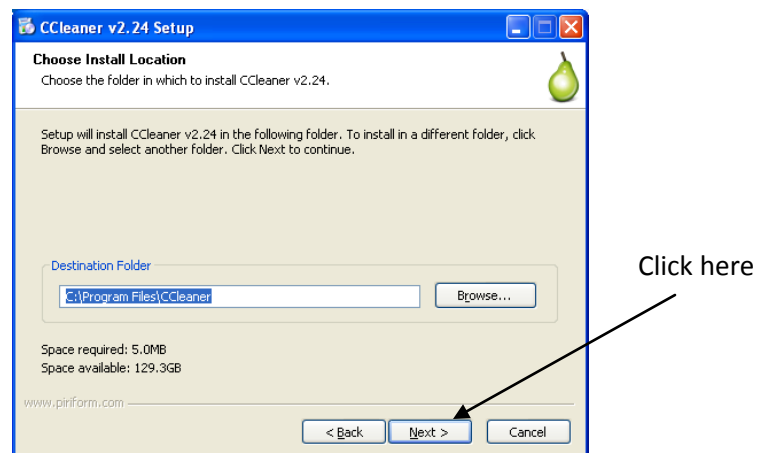
A CCleaner Setup Wizard will open. This wizard will guide you through the steps of setting up CCleaner. On the wizard's first window, click Next.



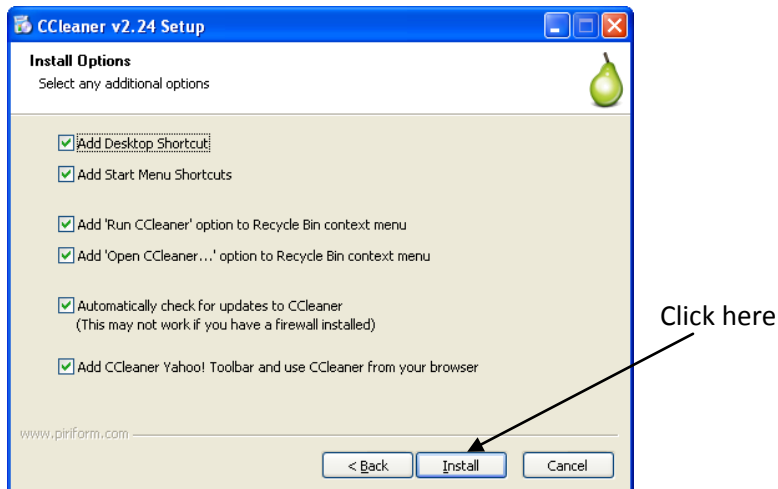
On the License Agreement window, Click I Agree.



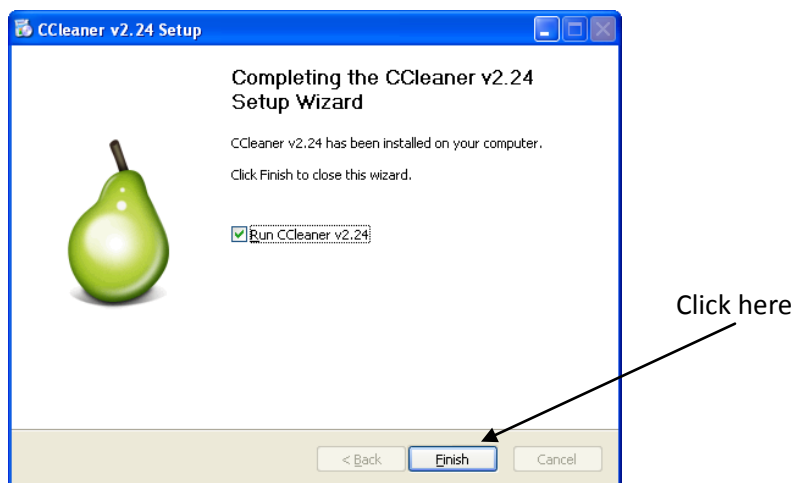
On the Location install window (where the file will be installed), click Next



A setup window will open to show the CCleaner options available. (The default installation has all of the options checked) Click Install.



Once the installation has finished, the wizard window will return. Click Finish (A window with the option to run CCleaner may then open. It is recommended to close out of all applications before running CCleaner.)



You have finished the install of CCleaner. Close out of all applications, double-click the CCleaner shortcut on your desktop, and run CCleaner.
