Music students at Amarillo College have the opportunity to engage in many different performing ensembles. A high standard for student conduct is expected from all community members and Amarillo College Students enrolled in any course to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all students and faculty. All participants must comply with the following:

- 1. Adhere to the Amarillo College Student Rights and Responsibilities document.
- 2. Be punctual for all rehearsals and events as outlined in the course syllabus.
- 3. Never engage in any inappropriate social interactions including but not limited to profane or lewd remarks.
- 4. Do not share or subject fellow students to offensive images or materials.
- 5. Sensitivity to the diverse views of the Amarillo College community is expected.
- 6. It is important to refrain from making unfavorable and/or slanderous remarks about fellow students and faculty members.
 - 7. Always dress appropriately.
- 8. Use of alcohol or illicit substances is not allowed while engaging in any Amarillo College activity.
- 9. Students under the influence of alcohol while participating in any AC sponsored activity will be subject to disciplinary action.
 - 10. Use of Music Department instruments is by permission only. Percussionists must store percussion equipment properly and other band members assist in ensuring all instruments, chairs, and stands are in place and secured after each rehearsal.

Students failing to perform according to the established Amarillo College Music Department code of conduct may be subject to disciplinary academic action or removal from the course.
