

Amarillo College Radiography Program

Radiography Admission Requirements:

- I have read and understand all admission requirements for acceptance into the Amarillo College Radiography Program which can be found on the Radiography web page or by contacting the program director; and,
- I understand for my application to be considered, I must attend a Radiography informational meeting and a video hospital visit; and,
- I know the principle duties and recommended characteristics of a Radiographer; and,
- I understand that I will have to have completed and provide documentation for the Texas immunization requirements prior to being involved in direct patient contact in program affiliated medical care facilities. Which include:
 - Two doses of MMR (measles, mumps, & rubella) vaccine
 - Three injections of hepatitis B vaccines
 - Two injections of varicella (Chicken Pox) vaccine
 - One dose of tetanus-diphtheria toxoid within the last ten years
 - Influenza vaccination prior to the seasonal flu season (must be completed annually)

- I have had the opportunity to ask questions concerning:
 - Current and future radiographer job availability; and,
 - Current and future starting salaries for new Radiography graduates; and,
- I have provided officials at Amarillo College with any applicable academic transcripts as requested in the Admission Criteria; and,
- I understand that my program application information must be current, complete, accurate, and to do otherwise could jeopardize my acceptance into the program; and,
- I agree to abide by all admission requirements and understand that my application does not guarantee me an appointment in the next Radiography class and that I must compete with other applicants for that appointment based on a point system that has been fully described in the admission process documentation.
