Student Club Constitution Template

*Please note, this is a sample outline to guide organizations on creating their constitutions. Articles below may or may not apply depending on each club's structure.

Article I: Name

The name of this organization shall be [club name], hereinafter referred to as [acronym, if applicable].

Article II: Purpose (Here is where you want to describe the purpose/mission of the organization. What is the desired outcome or goal of the club?)

Article III: Membership (This article should include who can become a member of the organization and is the minimum required by the Student Life Office to be included in all club constitutions. Additional requirements may include a specific program of study, a higher GPA, etc.)

Section II: Membership in *[club name]* is open to all persons without regard to race, color, creed, religion, national or ethnic origin, marital status, citizenship, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, age, disability, or protected veteran status.

Section III: Students must be enrolled in the semester of which they are a member of *[club name]*. Students must be enrolled in a minimum of 3 credit hours per 8-week semester, with a total minimum of 6 credit hours over the course of a 16 week semester, unless their program of study does not allow for it, to be a member of the *[club name]*.

Section IV: Membership in *[club name]* is limited to students who maintain a 2.0 or higher overall GPA.
