RED RAIDER GUARANTEE

If you are a resident of Texas and your family's adjusted gross income is \$65,000 or less, you may qualify for this program which guarantees tuition and mandatory fees through a combination of federal, state and institutional funds. To qualify, students must be an incoming freshmen or transfer student (with an associate's degree), and be enrolled full time. Your FAFSA should be received by our office no later than **January 15** for consideration. Learn more at financialaid.ttu.edu/guarantee.

GRANTS

STUDENT LOANS

Texas Tech participates in federal, state, and private loan programs which are available for you and your parents to assist in funding your college expenses.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships can be awarded based on academics, financial need, interests and other criteria. You will automatically be considered for our scholarships upon applying for admission. Scholarships can come from the university scholarships office, colleges, departments and external sources. goapplytexas.org | commonapp.org

NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

If you are awarded a combined total of at least \$1,000 in competitive scholarships from Texas Tech, you are eligible to pay in-state tuition during the academic year.

Texas Tech scholarships do not transfer to other institutions such as the TTU Health Sciences Center.

ACT composite score; SAT reflects evidence-based reading and writing, and math; the highest section scores from multiple tests on the ACT and SAT will be used to maximize score. These awards are for the 2025-2026 academic year and are subject to change without notice. No additional application is required. Students must enroll in a minimum of 12 hours for fall & spring terms.

Transfer Merit Scholarships are guaranteed for students who have transcripts and other required documents submitted by July 31 for Fall entry or January 15 for Spring entry. Scholarships are renewable for up to three consecutive years (six total terms). Students must enroll in a minimum of 12 credit hours; 9 must be TTU hours. Scholarships are awarded after June 1 based on availability of funds (fall entry). Students with approved consortium agreements must take a minimum of 9 TTU hours. Transferable hours exclude credit hours from AP, CLEP, or military credits. Students must meet all criteria to qualify.

UPGRADES & DEADLINE FOR MERIT SCHOLARSHIP AWARDING

Students may qualify for an upgrade to their merit scholarship based on improved scores or GPA. To qualify for an upgrade, students should report improved qualifications no later than **April 1**. Merit scholarships will continue to be awarded to qualifying students until this date.

EXTERNAL SCHOLARSHIPS

We process scholarships that are awarded to you from external sources such as local, civic, religious organizations and high schools. Other sources include the Texas Tech Alumni Association (texastechalumni.org), Texas Tech Parents Association (texastechparents.org) and the Terry Foundation (terryfoundation.org).
