RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS

Awards of \$7,000-\$9,000	3.5 GPA & 30 TTU hours
Awards of \$3,000-\$6,000	3.25 GPA & 30 TTU hours
Awards of \$1,000-\$2,000	3.0 GPA & 30 TTU hours

Awards are renewable for up to 4 consecutive years (eight total terms).

TEST OPTIONAL & SCHOLARSHIPS

Students who apply test-optional will be evaluated holistically for merit scholarships.

Transfer Merit Scholarships are guaranteed for students who have transcripts and other required documents submitted by July 31 for Fall entry or January 5 for Spring entry. Scholarships are renewable for up to three consecutive years (six total terms). Students must enroll in a minimum of 12 credit hours; 9 must be TTU hours. Scholarships are awarded after June 1 based on availability of funds (fall entry). Students with approved consortium agreements must take a minimum of 9 TTU hours. Transferable hours exclude credit hours from AP, CLEP, or military credits. Students must meet all criteria to qualify.

EXTERNAL SCHOLARSHIPS

We process scholarships that are awarded to you from external sources such as local, civic, religious organizations and high schools. Other sources include the Texas Tech Alumni Association (texastechalumni.org) and the Terry Foundation (terryfoundation.org). RED RAIDER GUARANTEE

If you're a resident of Texas and your family's adjusted gross income is \$65,000 or less, you may qualify for this program which guarantees tuition and mandatory fees through a combination of federal, state and institutional funds. To qualify, students must be an incoming freshmen or transfer student (with an associate's degree), and be enrolled full time. The priority date is January 15.
