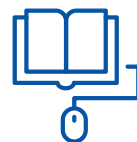

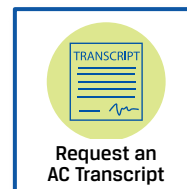

Apply online through the designated application portal system

- ☐ Set-up a profile
- ☐ Declare all colleges/universities attended
- ☐ Complete essays
- ☐ Pay application fee (if applicable); may qualify for a fee waiver

- ☐ Send official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended



Remember

- ✓ Check your email for the status of your application
- ✓ Send proof of meningitis vaccination
- ✓ Submit supplemental documents requested
- ✓ Complete your transfer orientation (in-person or online option)
- ✓ Once admitted; check your email for your next steps which can include:
 - Accepting your admissions status
 - Setting up your student portal, email and other systems
 - How to meet your advisor and register for classes
 - University parking permits
 - Student ID
 - Residential housing (on campus vs. commuter)
 - How to secure your books
 - Career Services (student employment)
 - Financial aid and scholarships assistance

Paying For My Education

- ☐ Complete [The Free Application for Federal Student Aid \(FAFSA\)](#) for all US citizens
- ☐ Complete [The Texas Application for State Financial Aid \(TASFA\)](#) for all non-US citizens
- ☐ Apply for university and external scholarships; connect with the university scholarship office
- ☐ Connect with the university career services department for employment opportunities
- ☐ Consider Federal Work-Study through FAFSA
- ☐ Check the status of your financial aid and scholarship awards



Reminders

- ⚠ Start early.** Begin your planning and preparation one year prior, especially for Top Tier universities. Some university programs only accept a fall enrollment. Do not wait until the term is over to begin the transfer process.
- ⚠ Do your research.** Take the same approach as you take in completing your course assignments.
- ⚠ Be consistent with the transfer process,** monitor your emails, complete additional requirements and adhere to deadlines.
